<p><b>These are symptoms of the flu</b> <i>Fever, sore throat, headache, muscle aches, cough, fatigue</i></p>	<p><b>How flu is spread from person to person</b> <i>Cough, sneeze, talk, or touching infected surface</i></p>	<p><b>Flu season occurs during these seasons</b> <i>Fall and winter, and possibly spring</i></p>
<p><b>How often is flu vaccine recommended for everyone 6 months and older?</b> <i>Every year</i></p>	<p><b>Number of flu-related hospitalizations per year in the U.S.</b> <i>200,000 people</i></p>	<p><b>These are ways to prevent the flu</b> <i>Wash hands, cover coughs &amp; sneezes, stay home if sick, get vaccinated</i></p>
<p><b>An additional dose of vaccine to keep you healthy as protection wears off</b> <i>Booster Dose</i></p>	<p><b>Shot that protects against three diseases (tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis)</b> <i>Tdap vaccine</i></p>	<p><b>A highly contagious bacterial disease that causes rapid, uncontrollable coughing fits</b> <i>Pertussis (whooping cough)</i></p>
<p><b>1 person in the U.S. gets cancer caused by HPV every _____.</b> <i>20 minutes</i></p>	<p><b>This virus commonly affects both boys and girls, and can lead to cancer</b> <i>Human Papillomavirus (HPV)</i></p>	<p><b>A serious bacterial infection that may result in inflammation of the lining of the brain and spinal cord</b> <i>Meningococcal disease</i></p>
<p><b>A booster dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine is needed at this age</b> <i>16 years</i></p>	<p><b>Adolescent vaccines (HPV, Tdap, Meningococcal) are recommended at this age</b> <i>11-12 years</i></p>	<p><b>Additional vaccines may be needed for this activity</b> <i>Travel</i></p>
<p><b>HPV infections can lead to this</b> <i>Cancer: cervical, penile, anal, oropharyngeal</i></p>	<p><b>This vaccine is a 2-dose series, if started before age 15</b> <i>HPV vaccine</i></p>	<p><b>How can meningococcal disease be spread?</b> <i>Sharing saliva, air droplets (sharing drinks, kissing, etc.)</i></p>
<p><b>Who is at risk for pertussis?</b> <i>Everyone</i></p>	<p><b>HPV infections are most common at this age range</b> <i>Teens and early 20s</i></p>	<p><b>Vaccines stimulate this to keep you healthy</b> <i>Immune system</i></p>
<p><b>These are symptoms of meningococcal disease</b> <i>Stiff neck, confusion, fatigue, severe headache, fever, sensitivity to light</i></p>	<p><b>These three presidents, Abraham Lincoln, Grover Cleveland, and James Garfield, all had children who died of this disease</b> <i>Diphtheria</i></p>	<p><b>This term means that the more people who are vaccinated makes it less likely for a disease to spread</b> <i>Herd immunity</i></p>
